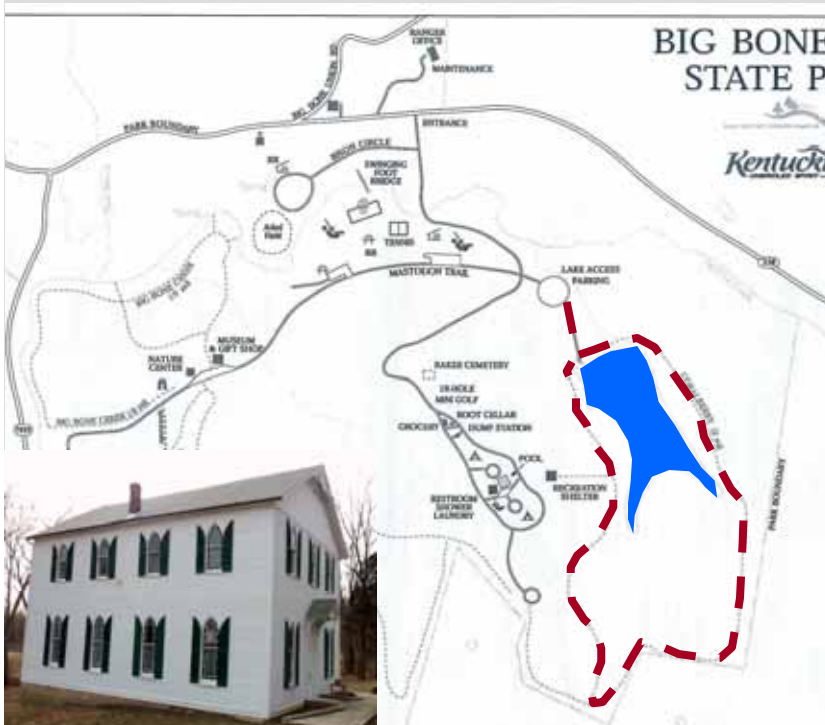


Hiking Treks



On Sunday, February 6, 2011, we hiked at Big Bone Lick State Park in northern Kentucky (near Union). There is only one major trail there, the Coralberry, which is a 2 mile loop around the lake.

Overall the trail is not difficult but is hilly. Nice vistas to the lake, which is frozen, during the winter. Trail markers are red squares.



Big Bone Lick is noted more for its pre-historic artifacts. There is also a bison herd here. During winter though most of the park facilities are closed.

Near the main entry is a beautifully restored structure but no info as to its original purpose. (Lower Left)

Nine miles to the south is famous 'Rabbit Hash' and country store.
