I believe the architect for it (SOM) is the same as the Cathedral of Light in Oakland.



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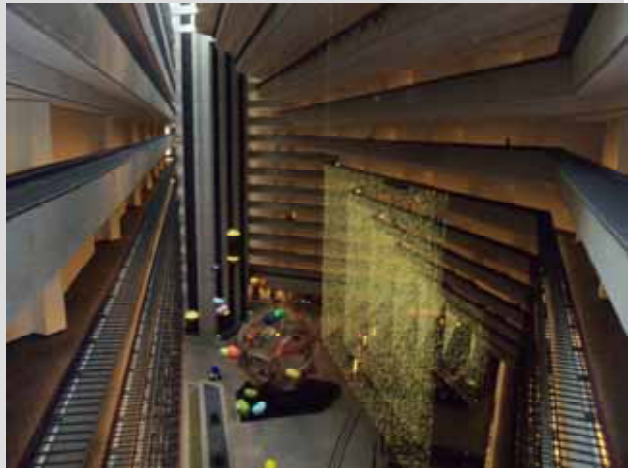
This is a Jewish Synagogue that is near Golden Gate park.
